

Volunteer Shifts

Box Packing: Volunteers during this shift help to pack our dry good boxes that are distributed to our partner agencies as well as to our families and clients at our drive thru distributions. Packing is done using a manual assembly line and does include standing for periods of time and very light lifting. This shift is in a warehouse environment, closed toe shoes are a must.

Drive-Thru Distribution: Volunteers during this shift help to load our client's cars with approximately 100 lbs of food including fresh produce, frozen meats, dairy, dry goods and household items. Our drive thru distribution is located at 2530 Cape Horn Road. This shift is outdoors rain or shine, so please dress accordingly.





Drive-Thru Distribution-Traffic Control:

Volunteers during this shift help to direct traffic and maintain a safe flow of traffic during our drive thru distribution located at 2530 Cape Horn Road. This shift is outdoors rain or shine, so please dress accordingly.



Senior Box Packing: Volunteers during this shift help to pack non perishable items for our Senior Box Program. Our Senior Box Program provides nutritious food to over 1500 York County Seniors each month.

Packing is done using a manual assembly line and does include standing for periods of time and very light lifting.





Misc. Jobs - Sorting/Building Boxes/Bagging/General Cleaning:

Volunteers during this shift will help to sort food donations, bag loose items such as fresh fruits and vegetables, assemble the boxes that are packed with dry goods and provide general cleaning such as sweeping or any other light duty cleaning needed to maintain the facility.

Partner Agency Volunteering: The York County Food Bank supports 65 partner agencies within York County. These partners include food pantries, community centers, schools, senior centers, soup kitchens and others. Our agencies rely heavily on volunteers to help with their distributions, deliveries, and warehouse needs. In addition to supporting our agencies with food and resources, we are also helping them with their volunteer needs.

Volunteer shifts for our partner agencies are posted on our volunteer calendar along with our shifts for YCFB. Each shift posted will include our partner agency name, address, a brief description, as well any specific directions such as dress or mask requirements.
