Dear Friends,

In 2025, York County continued

to experience extraordinary need — and our community rose to meet it. Thanks to your generosity, we distributed **4.1 million pounds of food** and provided **3.4 million healthy meals** to our neighbors. Every month, more than **40,000 people** counted on us, a level of demand that has held steady since last year.

This work is powered by compassion. A grandmother told us, “These boxes help me feed my grandkids and keep the lights on.” A young mother shared that our online pantry program allows her family to eat fresh, healthy food with dignity. And more than **500 volunteers** gave **11,000 hours**, saving nearly

\$400,000 in labor costs while ensuring every neighbor was welcomed with warmth and respect.



Food Security Network

As the central food hub for York County, we lead a network of **100+ feeding partners** that ensures consistent access to nutritious food throughout the county.



Senior Boxes & Home Deliveries

Over **25,000 senior boxes** were delivered to older adults this year. Many deliveries reached homebound seniors through our transportation partners.



Mass Drive-Thru & Mobile Bus Distributions

More than 150 large-scale events brought fresh produce, dairy, proteins, and pantry staples directly to families — ensuring fast, dignified access regardless of transportation barriers.



Online Pantry Program

Our Online Pantry Program offers a convenient, private way for families to order the foods they need and pick them up at a scheduled time. This model reduces wait times, improves dignity of choice, and supports neighbors with limited mobility, transportation, or work schedule flexibility.

Opening in 2026, The Market @ Princess St. will be a state-of-the-art, client-choice shopping experience designed to increase access to fresh and healthy foods. The renovated space will feature expanded refrigeration, improved flow, wraparound services, and community-centered programming. 

Local Farm & Food Sourcing Partnerships
